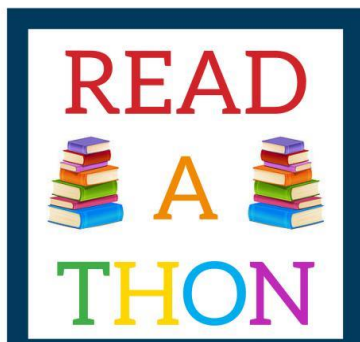
Your PAC has come up with an idea on how to get the kids motivated to read!
